

European Motorcycle Training Quality Label



What is the European Motorcycle Training Quality Label?

- It is a joint initiative operated by three organisations: the German Road Safety Council, a German NGO in the field of road safety, the European Association of Motorcycle Manufacturers (ACEM), and the International Motorcycling Federation (FIM)
- The Label is also endorsed by the European Traffic Safety Council (ETSC).

How does the Training Quality Label work in practice?

- The Label is a voluntary certification scheme for post-licence safety training programmes. It helps motorcyclists easily identify the best safety training programmes in their countries.
- Training programmes are only awarded the scheme if they pass an independent assessment run by the German Road Safety Council, which includes an on-the-spot inspection and evaluation
- Further to this, annual on-site evaluation visits by motorcycle safety experts are performed to ensure that the training programme continues to be delivered to a high standard.

What has been achieved so far?

- Only 2 years after the launch of the label, a total of 28 motorcycle training programmes have been certified.
- Motorcyclists in Sweden, France, Spain, the Netherlands, Austria and Germany now know which training schools offer the best post-licence training options.
- The latest applicants are training bodies from Belgium and Cyprus.
